Tāmaki Makaurau Auckland (23 – 27 August) / Ōtautahi Christchurch (28 – 30 August)  
with General Assembly on the mornings of 24, 25, 26 and 27 August.

The dates of the **Asian Composers League Festival 2022** are:  
Ōtautahi Christchurch: Sunday 28 August 3.15pm – Wednesday 31 August (late evening)

If you are planning to attend the Festival in person, the registration process for booking nights in the Festival Hotels is now open, and we urge you to register as soon as possible:
